 - (i) **Issue 9-24-27 A365 Bath Road Bowerhill**: To note that the works order for improvements on the A365 Bath Road on both approaches to Bowerhill Lane junction has been issued to the contractor.
 - (ii) Issue 9-24-11 Semington Road by mobile home park: To note that further discussion is needed with Melksham Without Parish Council and the affected resident before progressing further. Cost estimate is £2000.
 - (iii) **Issue 9-24-25 Semington Road outside New Inn:** To note that the options of a bus boarder platform were discussed and that further discussion is required with Melksham Without Parish Council.
 - (iv) **Issue 9-24-30 Halifax Road bollard opposite school:** To note that the area is unsuitable for bollards and that concern was raised about the cost of Birdsmouth fencing as an alternative. To note that further discussion is needed with Melksham Without Parish Council.
 - (v) **Issue 9-24-37 Bowerhill Estate holistic review of dropped kerbs:** To note that further discussion is needed with Melksham Without Parish Council.
 - (vi) **Melksham Dunch Lane** funded by Section 106 monies from George Ward Gardens development: To note feedback from Wiltshire Councillor Alford.
 - (vii) **Issue 9-24-34 Bowerhill Finger Post:** To note feedback from Melksham Men's Shed
 - To note that the consultation period for the Parking Control Measures/Waiting Restrictions (double yellow lines) is complete. The Cabinet member report has

been finalized and will be published in due course. Implementation is likely early autumn. (Issues 9-22-17,9-23-3 & 9-23-5)
