UPDATE FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL

Melksham Without Parish Council has had a busy Summer, working on the review of the Neighbourhood Plan following the consultation period in July and August, as well as reviewing planning applications for large developments in the parish and the public consultations for Lime Down Solar amongst others.

Plenty of planned maintenance, with the replacement of the safety surfacing at the Hornchurch Road play area, and grant funding obtained to improve the pitches at Bowerhill Sports Field. Flood prevention support in Shaw and Whitley following Storm Henk earlier in the year, and a new village gate in Beanacre. Planning appeals, planning enforcement and concerns of speeding are issues that have been raised in Berryfield that we are trying to tackle.

Thoughts now turn to the New Year, with recruitment, a new grass-cutting contract and the budget currently being worked on, with the opportunity for community groups and organisations that directly benefit the residents of the parish able to apply for grant funding, with a deadline of 31st January.

If this all sounds like something that interests you, then do consider standing for the elections on 1st May 2025 when town, parish and Wiltshire Council councillors are all up for election. Now is a great time to come along to council meetings and listen in and see if it's something that you would like to get involved with; improving and supporting the community you live in. Do contact the Clerk to have an informal chat about the time commitment and what the role entails.
